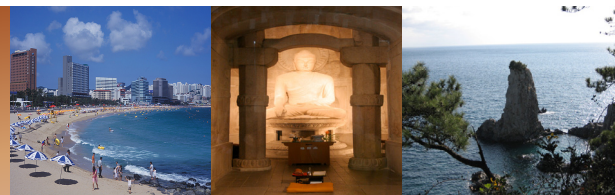

Day 1 Departure

Check-in Airport for your departure flight.

Day 2 International Day Line

Day 3 Seoul(Korea) – Busan

Arrival Seoul and connect a domestic flight to Busan, the 2nd largest city of Korea. After arrival, visit **Yongdusan Park**, **Busan Tower**, and **Jagalchi Fish Market** - Korea's largest seafood market. Next to **Taejongdae Park**, a hilly and heavily forested area with rugged cliffs dropping straight down to the sea below. Continue to **Nurimaru APEC House** in Haeundae Beach, served as the conference center for the 2005 APEC meeting. (Lunch, Dinner)

Day 4 Busan – Gyeongju - Daegu

After breakfast, transfer to **Tongdosa Temple**, one of the largest temples in Korea. A temple that preserves Bulbo or Shakyamuni, the best of the three treasures of Buddhism. Then transfer to Gyeongju, an ancient capital of Silla Dynasty (BC57~AD935). Visit the highlight of this tour - the **Bulguksa Temple**, built during the most glorious period of the Korea. Next to **Seogulram Grotto** - the home of serene stone Buddha of the eighth century, with a white serene statue of a seated Buddha in a sublime state of enlightenment and surrounded by Bodhisattva, disciples and guardians. Bulguksa Temple and Seogulram Grotto are on the list of UNESCO world cultural heritage. Drive to Daegu. (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

Day 5 Daegu - Suwon

Morning visit **Yangnyeongsi Exhibition Hall**, the oriental medicine museum, display more than 500 items including many famous oriental medicine books. You may even try to taste various medicinal teas. Drive north to **Korean Folk Village** and **Suwon Hwaseong Fortress**. Suwon Hwaseong is a well-preserved structure of the Joseon Dynasty built of stones and oven-baked bricks, listed as one of the UNESCO's World Cultural Heritages.

Day 6 Suwon - Seoul

Morning drive to Seoul, the capital of South Korea. First, pass by the **Blue House**, office and residence of the President. Then visit **Cheonggyecheon Stream**. It symbolizes the harmony of the past and future. Then take a tour of the **Changdeokgung Palace**. It has been the residence of many kings and main Palace, inscribed on the UNESCO World Cultural Heritage list. Afternoon visit the Korean Food & Cultural Center. Learn to make your own **Kimchi** - the most famous dish of Korea, and try on traditional Korean custom - **Hanbok**. Then to famous Ginseng Center. Have some times at the local wholesale **Dongdaemun Market**. In the evening, enjoy the funny and entertaining show that hit Broadway with a surprise - **NANTA (Cookin)**. It is a must see in Korea. (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

Then to the **Mysterious Road** where cars are rolling uphill by itself.
